The **“Cruze for Junior”** is an awareness campaign beginning July 2-9 2013. A Cruze schedule has been approved and will include the media stops throughout the trip. The maximum number of vehicles that will be accepted into the convoy is 25, therefore only the first 25 vehicle registrants will be accepted.

Cost to Participate

Participants will be responsible for their own expenses for the Cruze ie. Hotels/campgrounds fuel, food etc. Participants are encouraged to solicit donations to cover the costs of the Cruze. Entrance fee per vehicle is \$50.00. Each vehicle will be provided with 4 magnets.

Rules for participating in the “Cruze for Junior”

The success of this Cruze depends on the safety of each participant The Cruze will take place during a time when the roads will be very busy with tourists, families travelling on holidays. It is a condition to participate in the Cruze that all participants explicitly follow all rules.

Every vehicle must have two way communication.

All road laws must be adhered to all times.

The event marshal will alert all participants when the convoy will be leaving. All vehicles will depart together. Those vehicles that are not prepared to leave at the time the convoy leaves will be on their own until the next destination.

At no time shall vehicles pass the Convoy Lead Vehicle.

All vehicles will post the Cruze Logo and maintain a copy of the Cruze schedule.

All participants must act responsibly and be fit (well rested) for travel.

Should your vehicle break down during the Cruze the lead vehicle must be notified. The Cruze will continue and you must organize your own resources to have your vehicle towed or repaired. Should a participant at any time during the Cruze violate any of the rules here stated or that stated during the Cruze, will be ask to leave the Cruze convoy.

The organizers of Cruze for Junior will not be held responsible or liable for any damages, injuries or expenses incurred by the participant while participating in the Cruze for Junior.
